Re: Venezuela Hunger Relief

Dear Pastor:

New Melle Baptist Church last year took up the call to help Multi Centro Cristiano Bathel in Barquisimeto, Venezuela with finances to buy food and medicine. The Socialist government of President Maduro has destroyed the once flourishing economy of Venezuela. Food and medicine is in short supply and beyond the financial resources of many people. Speaking with some of the members we know personally at the church, we have learned they are eating maybe one meal a day. The cost of one egg is 20,000 Bolivars, which is equal to \$4.00. We cannot help all of Venezuela but we have chosen to partner with this one evangelical church that is spreading the gospel and attempting to meet real needs, in a real way, and for the right purpose.

Many people are fleeing to other countries so they can live, work and survive. An election is to be held later in April, we are praying with the people of Venezuela for a free uncorrupted election, and a new President who will love the people of Venezuela and help restore the country and the economy.

We are asking that your church pray and consider partnering with us to provide financial offerings for the Venezuelan Hunger Relief. Checks and offerings can be made payable and sent to: New Melle Baptist Church, purpose Venezuela Hunger Relief.

We are not sending food for two reasons: (1) costs of shipping, and (2) it would not get through customs but would in all probability be confiscated by the military

and stored in warehouses to be distributed to those connected to the Maduro regime.
